## Grammar- The Imperfect tense

You use the 'imperfect' tense to talk about what things **'used to be like'** but also to describe what **'was happening'**.

### Examples:

Je jouais - I was playing  
Je regardais - I was watching

### Different subjects

To write the imperfect tense with 'Il/Elle' the ending changes to 'ait'

Il jouait - He was playing  
Il regardait - He was watching
