
















# Tips to help support your child with their language learning



<p>Encourage them to make flashcards then quiz them to help them practise their vocabulary and 'Keys'</p> 	<p>Ask them to tell you what they've learnt that day- retrieving knowledge from memory strengthens the memory and leads to deeper learning</p> 	<p>Get them to teach you something they've learnt that day in their language lesson</p> 
<p>Encourage them to speak in French/German/Spanish at home as much as possible!</p> 	<p>Teachers will give regular feedback on what students can do to improve- ask your child what this is and how they're going to tackle it</p> 	<p>Encourage them to use their Sentence Builders and 'Keys' booklets to help them complete homework tasks and revise vocabulary</p> 
<p>Encourage them to use Languagenut and Quizlet independently to develop their vocabulary &amp; listening, speaking, reading and writing skills</p> 	<p>Ask them to create a mind map of everything they can remember from a unit of work</p> 	<p>Explore the French/German/Spanish culture pages on our department website</p>
